Dear Administrator Jackson:

I am pleased to certify on behalf of New Mexico that all American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds received from the Environmental Protection Agency under the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) capitalization grant as amended for the amount of \$23,789,100 are under contract or construction as of February 11, 2010, as required. The permitted set-aside for administrative costs under the CWSRF of four percent of the original ARRA allotment in the amount of \$769,564 is part of New Mexico Environment Department's EPA-approved Intended Use Plan and is included in the \$23,789,100. Projects on the project certification list amount to \$23,019,536 and this excludes the administrative cost of \$769,564.

The seventeen projects throughout New Mexico that are receiving ARRA CWSRF assistance are identified in the attached list with the specific information requested on each project provided. Additionally, a final certification pursuant to Title XV, Subtitle A, Section 1511 of the ARRA has been completed and is available to the public.

I certify that all representations made in this letter and in the accompanying attachments are true.


