<b>Purpose of allocation:</b>	Reduce the initial allocation from \$250,000 to \$224,949 to reflect the actual amount to be expended for the provision of residential crisis and family services for children and their families in the Las Cruces/Dona Ana County area. This area has experienced a high rate of child abuse cases resulting in the death of young children. Funds will: (1) provide a crisis shelter care center to provide a safe and secure setting for children birth through five years of age; and (2) allow the crisis shelter to partner with other community agencies and resources to provide needed services and supports to children receiving services, as well as coordinate services to affected parents. This allocation may be used for services in FY11 and FY12.
