Services will benefit schools and educators statewide, with a special focus on rural school districts in Northern New Mexico. Services will provide a consistent, sustained, high-quality technical assistance program to rural school districts and communities serving culturally and linguistically diverse students. The allocation will fund:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Educational leadership program 2. Community-based education summits with select New Mexico Pueblo and Tribal leaders 3. Improve teaching and learning for culturally and linguistically diverse students through classroom observation, trainings, workshops, and coaching. Training will align with New Mexico state standards and Common Core Standards. 4. Principal Leadership Academies for 28 rural, northern school districts 5. Provide online tools, sample lesson plans, and other resources for teachers and administrators. 6. Disseminate findings and best practices for culturally and linguistically diverse learners to all New Mexico school districts.
