The New Mexico Rail Runner Express is operated pursuant to the October 20, 2009 Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between Rio Metro, the New Mexico Department of Transportation, and the Mid-Region Council of Governments for Commuter Rail Service for the Belen to Santa Fe Corridor, which defines the respective and joint responsibilities of Rio Metro and the NM Department of Transportation. Under the MOA, Rio Metro is generally responsible for the operation, administration and management of the New Mexico Rail Runner Express service, including managing the money and paying the costs of the service. Consequently, it is the only eligible subgrantee.
