Complete project as per budget included with application. If there are any changes to this budget or additional funds required to complete the project, this information must be submitted to NMORR.4. Implementing Agency shall prepare for NMORR review and approval a decision brief, including a detailed expenditure plan.5. Implementing Agency will comply with ARRA reporting requirements and U.S. Department of Education monitoring requirements.
